Recycling Information

✓ Paper products, glass, cans and plastics (**no styrofoam**) should be cleaned and placed together in a blue box or container not exceeding 121 litres (32 gallons); separation of recyclables is not necessary.

✓ Additional blue boxes can be purchased from Public Works or Customer Service, City Hall for \$7.00 per box.

✓ **New - fast food coffee cups and lids (not styrofoam) rinsed plastic flower pots and trays (no hangers)**

Recyclables

- ✓ Newspapers, flyers and magazines
- ✓ Bundled Cardboard (1m x 1m x 1/2m thick)
- ✓ Plastics coded 1 through 7
- ✓ Rinsed flower pots and trays
- ✓ Empty, dry metal paint cans
- ✓ Glass bottles and metal cans
- ✓ Fast food coffee cups and lids
- ✓ Tetra pak boxes
- ✓ Milk and juice cartons
- ✓ Aluminum plates and trays
- ✓ Clean pizza boxes (no food)

Compost Collection Information

✓ Compostables (leaves, grass, garden waste) must be in clear bags, paper bags or open containers marked on two sides with an "X".

✓ Brush must be in paper bags or open containers marked on two sides with an "X" or be bundled with a compostable material (jute or twine) and be no longer than 4 feet long. The maximum number of bundles is 10.

✓ Brush includes branches up to four inches in diameter, twigs, hedges, shrubs and rose bushes.

✓ Christmas trees or brush in plastic bags **will not be collected.**

Compost Site Information

Monday - Saturday

April 1 to December 14, 9am to 5:00pm; Closed Holidays

Compostables can be dropped off at the Compost Site at 379 St. Andrew Street during business hours only. There is no charge for leaves, grass and garden waste, but there is a charge for brush drop-off.

Set Out Requirements-All Collectible Materials

✓ Any approved material set out for collection must be on the boulevard or driveway by the curb before 7am on your collection day and no earlier than 6pm the day before.

✓ No material is to be set out on the road or in the gutter.

Waste Information

✓ Residential waste - three bag or three container limit.

✓ Maximum weight of each bag/container is 22kg (48lbs).

✓ Commercial waste - six bag or six container limit.

✓ Additional bags or containers must have a bag tag.

Large Item Pick-up

✓ Large items will be picked up during the first full week of the month on your collection day for properties seven units or less. This does not include junk items in boxes.

✓ Furniture

✓ Stoves

✓ Barbecues - no propane tanks

✓ Mattresses

✓ Carpet must be rolled and tied, no longer than 4 feet

✓ Refrigerators and freezers must be purged of Freon and tagged by a refrigeration company

Construction Materials

Toilets, sinks, vanities, windows, drywall, lumber, ceramic tile, broken concrete, asphalt etc. **will not** be picked up at the boulevard. Please contact Transco Recycling (519-332-4045) or Curran Recycling (519-332-0849) for drop-off locations and times.

Household Hazardous Waste Day - drop off

*Starting July 1, 2019, plastic bags **cannot** be used for the set out of recyclables. Recyclables will only be collected in a blue box or blue container, not exceeding 121 litres (32 gallons). Recyclables in plastic bags **will not** be picked up.

Brush Collection Requirements

Brush is to be tied by a compostable material (jute or twine) and be no longer than 4 feet long. Brush in plastic bags **will not** be collected.

Compost Site

The compost site is located at 379 St. Andrew St. Acceptable methods of payment at the compost site are **credit and debit cards**. Cash and cheques will not be accepted.

Mixing recyclables with waste could result in fines under the City of Sarnia's Waste Collection By-Law.
