SUBJECT: Voter Turnout

As of approximately 9:00 a.m. on Monday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 19,138 voters have voted in the 2018 municipal and school board election. This represents 37.4% of the approximate 51,160 eligible voters in Sarnia.

The municipal and school board election voting period began October 11 at 9:00 a.m. and ends October 22 at 8:00 p.m. Eligible voters can vote by phone or internet. Voter Help Centres will be available during the voting period.
