

BY-LAW NUMBER 137 OF 2018  
OF THE CITY OF SARNIA

**"A By-Law to Amend By-Law Number 145 of 1991"**

---

**(Re: Streets By-Law – Winter Maintenance on Sidewalks)**

**WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient to amend By-Law 145 of 1991 of the City of Sarnia, being "A By-Law Respecting Streets" to amend paragraph 6 and Schedule "A" of the said By-Law.

**AND WHEREAS** the Ontario Regulation 366/18 made under the Municipal Act, 2001 Amending O. Reg. 239/02 (Minimum Maintenance Standards for Municipal Highways) provides for the closing of parts of highways/sidewalks for winter maintenance.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Sarnia, pursuant to the Municipal Act 2001, enacts as follows:


1. By-Law Number 145 of 1991 of the City of Sarnia is amended as follows
  - i. The section name "6" is deleted and replaced with "6 (a)";
  - ii. The following section is added following the aforementioned section:


"6.(b) The City of Sarnia may conduct winter maintenance on sidewalks identified in Schedule 'A-12' – Sidewalks Snow Plowing Route Map, in accordance with the Municipal Act, 2001, 2001, S.O. 2001, c 25, and applicable regulations, as amended."

"6.(c) That all sidewalks and boulevards not contained within the designated areas identified in Schedule 'A-1' to 'A-12' are temporarily closed from November 1st each year and re-opened on April 30<sup>th</sup> in the subsequent year"

- iii. To add the attached schedule, "Schedule 'A-12'" annexed hereto, following the "SCHEDULE 'A-11'" within the said by-law.

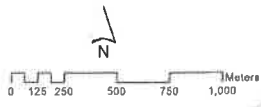

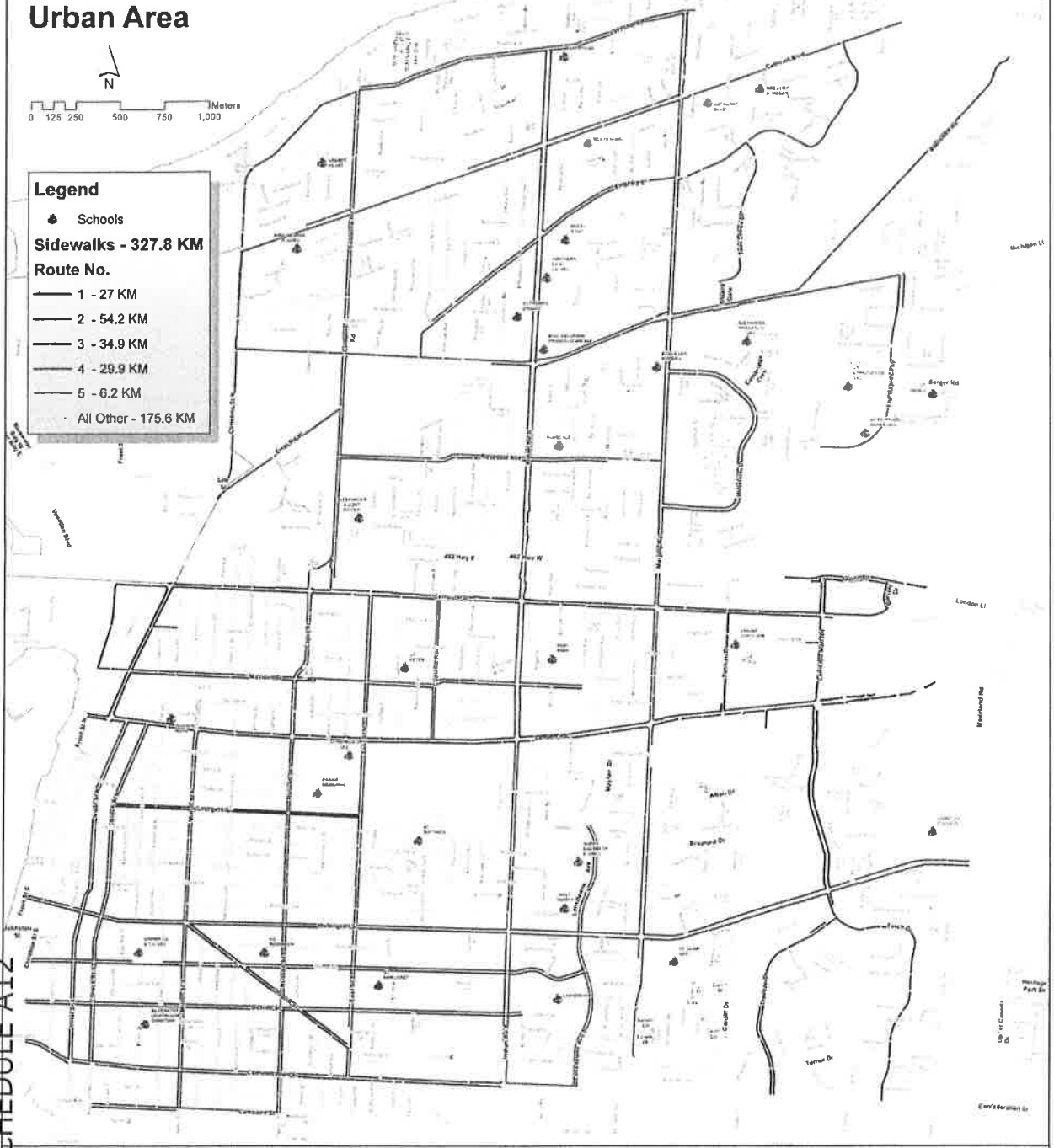
